
With problems from rebels expected, Brutacus has taken seven soldiers with him to one of the main squares in Alexandria and posted them in pairs as guards in each corner. Some of them have given clues as to which corner of the square they are positioned at, but they are not too bright and in each case only the first direction in their statement is true, whilst the other is the

statement is true, whilst the other is the exact opposite, so that East should read West etc. Directions are not necessarily exact so North could be North,

Northeast or Northwest. Brutacus himself is in corner D as shown on the diagram and your job is to correctly post the other seven soldiers to the correct corner of the square - it doesn't matter which guard box they are in as long as they are in the correct corner!



Octavius says: I'm South of Flavius and East of Julius
Cassius says: I'm East of Octavius and North of Julius
Decimus says: I'm North of Brutacus and West of Quintus
Servius says: I'm North of Cassius and East of Decimus
